Ray Kane – (20) 9/2 – Unknown playing ability from the rest of the field, beware, this is not a dark horse, more of a STALLION!

Paddy Lyons - (19) – 9/2 – Pride is at stake on this runner, an exit from the recent All Ireland against Kerry has this runner set for all guns blazing. Loves nothing better than beating a big field. Hungry for success. Worth a punt!

John Doddy – (19) – 4/1 – Alarm bells should ring for all punters. This runner with odds like these is a great bet. He has seen many battles over the years and comes good. Beware all!

Shane Carthy – (18) 5/1 – The Roy Keane/ Tommy Tiernan of the field no doubt! Takes no prisoners and can surprise all! Price is most tempting for punters and either way, you will be entertained.

Ronan McGoldrick – (21) 10/1 – As always will do his utmost to unsettle the field. Has the potential to be leading come half way. Can he carry it to the end this year?? Expect a top 3 finish if he keeps his cool!!!

Stephen McGovern - (24) 16/1 – With this handicap you cannot rule out. Has a point to prove after last years display and has practised loooooaaaaaadddsssss over the past 12 months.

Colin Ashmore – (24) 16/1 – A far better runner than what the odds would suggest. Best value runner in the field. Beware all! A shock could be on the cards..
